- ✓ 1. Manuscript copy of the popular little womens' occult books, treating of childbirth, labor, etc. The m.s. title page reads: "Nuetzliches und sehr bewahrt befundenes Weiberbuechlein..." Ephrata: 1822. small 4to. 20pp
This copy does not have an ownership signature and is unbound, the last page dated 1832. The Library Company owns five earlier of the printed editions of this work.

- ✓ 2. Musical notebook, containing scores and words of church songs, belonging to Daniel Jung. The title page reads: "Harmonisch neu eingerichtet evangelisches Choral-Buch, welches die Melodien derer beyden hier in America neu eingerichteten, und in Pennsylvanien herausgegebenen Evangelisch-Lutherisch und Reformirten Gesang Buchern in sich halt...zum Lobe Gottes geschrieben im Jahr 1800 [by] Daniel Jung, [Reading.]" The copy is in very good condition, neatly written and bound. 8vo. 160pp with 17pp index.

- ✓ 2a. Another musical notebook belonging to Johann Daniel Jung of Reading, Pa. This one contains 149 Psalms and numerous hymns, with an index at the end. The inside front cover bears the name of Samuel L. Jung, Reading, Penna. Then follows a whole page of note by Johann Daniel Jung of Northampton County, written in 1793. This note reads: "Was die Psalmen Davied angeht, hat solche erstlich Clemens Matot, einer von des Konigs Francisci I...in Franzoesische Reime zu ubersetzen angefangen...", giving bibliographical history of the translators and editors of the songbook he himself transcribes here. 4to. 221pp and index. Old binding.

- ✓ 3. Musical notebook containing scores and words. The first page is handsomely colored with the typical fraktur design, bearing the name of Anna Berkholter. Undated. 1834
Oblong 8vo. 24pp Old binding.

- ✓ 4. Musical notebook of some marches, waltzes, etc., mentioning the names of Lafayette and Washington. The old binding bears the name of Reuben Harn, dated 1830. Oblong 4to. stained.

- ✓ 5. Musical notebook, containing musical scores and words on 19pp. Oblong 16mo, old wrappers. With colored m.s. ex libris (fraktur design) "Dieses schoene Notenbuch gehoeret mir zu Johannes Kinsie... 1813."

- ✓6. Musical notebook of church hymns. The first page begins Jacob Spangler of the borough of York...Pennsylvania. Clockmaker and Silver Smith. Living in high street in the borough of York. Where all Sorts of Trochilious horologees are Fabricated and Renuated in the best and Neatest manner."

- ✓7. Two musical notebooks, oblong octavos, undated and unsiged in old leather and cloth binding. The one copy containing a melody register, the other some Organ and Piano instructions to be played in the First German Reformed Church in Reading.
- ✓8. A Lutheran Catechism in sheep binding. There is no owner's name, but an inscription saying "Beginn zu schreiben dieses de. 19 Januar An. 1760."

- ✓9. A calf leather bound manuscript copy of "Some Extracts from Materials towards a History of the American Baptists in 12 volumes. By Morgan Edwards, Am. Fellow of Rhode Island college and overseer of the Baptist Church in Philadelphia. Vol. 1st." With book plate of the Friends' Library in Philadel.
8vo. 90pp no signature.
- ✓10. A little book of charades and poems, undated. The first page is inscribed "Allerlei fur Caroline Antenrieth."
- ✓11. Small octavo manuscript of five sermons, dated from 1764-1765. There is no signature.
62pp unbound.
- ✓12. Small unbound manuscript of medical recepies for people and animals, partly taken from the popular little book "Kurzgefasste Arzeneybuechlein fur Menschen und Vieh." On page 5 of this m.s. copy is written "Ein Artzeney buch abgeschrieben for Mensch und fo[r] fieh zu brauch." The last page ends "1728, De Jahr hab ich so vonn Nicholas Muller meinem Herr..." 8vo.
- ✓13. Oblong 4to. m.s. of the "Superintendent's Minute and Attendance Register of the Kutztown Sunday School Union. 1847."
46pp with wrappers.

- ✓14. An interesting sheep-bound manuscript of Henry Muehlenberg, containing a collection of miscellaneous information, such as the dimensions of the globe, memoranda, and chiefly latin and biblical quotations. The first page is inscribed "Sammlung verschiedener Anmerkungen. Muhlenberg." 8vo.
- ✓15. Small oblong octavo musical notebook, containing scores and titles of humns in German, with an index at the end. The first page is inscribed "Dieses Noten Buch gehoret mir Daniel Weitzel." Undated. 86pp old binding, worn.
- ✓16. Musical notebook, scores and words, with a front index. Hand-colored first page ex libris "Dieses Primmiges (?) nodenbuchlein gehoret mir; Samuel Lande. Geschrieben den 4ten Marz in 1813..." Oblong octavo, 158pp; old binding.
- ✓17. Musical notebook, unsigned and undated. With scores, and hymn titles. Oblong 8vo. 104pp old binding.
- ✓18. Oblong 4to. musical notebook of hymns iwth an index in the end. The first page bears the ownership signature of Johann Schweitzer, dated 1784. On the last page is written a note telling that J. Schweitzer died on 3. June, 1786, aged 23. Following the owner's musical transcriptions are 4 songs done by different persons with their signatures. 4to. 142pp with index, old binding.
- ✓19. Musical notebook containing scores and words of hymns, with an alphabetical index at the end. The work is done in a very handsome hand and neat manner. The inside front cover is inscribed: "Jacob Spengler gehoret dieses Noten Buch, 1788." 4to. 92pp plus index. old binding.
- ✓20. Oblong folio musical notebook, containing classical pieces from Wagner, and some Waltzes and Marches. There is no ownership signature, but the manuscript is very neatly done and has a genuine artistic appearance.
- ✓21. Small duo volume of verses appearantly written by different students to a teacher. Most signatures, which appear at the end of each verse, are from Salem, North Carolina. They are dated from 1827 to 1832, and are accompanied by several lovely drawings. Old binding with stitched silk cover.
- ✓22. A Catholic Catechism, written in an unidentified language, with colored ink and handcolored border-design. On the first page is written "Duchowni Poklad Arneb Modlitby Katolicke... So Letafane, 1807."

With frontis and one other plate, both depicting religious scenes. In gilded calf leather binding. small 8vo.

- ✓ 23. A book of charades; 39pp, 4to. unbound. Undated, but on lined paper (ca. 1835) Inside cover ex libris "W. E. Allen's book of charades, Riddles, etc. William Allen." With numerous little newspaper clippings pasted in inside end cover.
- ✓ 24. Schoolbook, lined paper and printed wrappers. Printed in Philadelphia by T. S. Manning, sold by G. W. Mentz. 4to. Ex libris John G. Wink of Kutztown. First page begins "Day Book John Wink. September the 10th, A. D. 1838."
- ✓ 25. Two Schoolbooks, 4to. lined paper and wrappers with woodcuts. Ex libris Susan M. Carson, 1844-1845.
- ✓ 26. Schoolbook, 4to. lined paper and wrappers with woodcuts. Ex libris Emaline Cope, 1844.
- ✓ 27. Three school books, 4to. printed wrappers: Potter & Hammonds ...progressive Penmanship...Shermerhorn, Bancroft & Co. Philadelphia. M.S. date 1865.
- 7 ✓ 28. Algebra Note Book of Simple Additions, Divisions, Multiplications, etc., kept in a very beautiful manner. The first page is handcolored with a Pennsylvania-Dutch design; on the verso the page begins: "Numerations. Tabelle...Susanna Schults ihr Rechenbuch, von der Hannover Taunship Montgomery County, A. D. 1832." fol. 84pp old binding, clean, good condition.
- ✓ 29. A School Book of Geometry. A very handsome and neat work. The first page, with a handcolored design, is inscribed "1829, William H. Wogdes's book. Willistown School." The geometrical problems are accompanied by numerous colored drawings. fol. 120pp old binding.
- ✓ 30. Four very handsome School Note Books, belonging to a Howard H. Hopkins.
- a. Book of Geometry, with drawings, dated July 1830. fol. 46pp with wrappers
 - b. Book of Single Bookkeeping with colored ink headings. fol. 26pp and wrappers. Dated August 1830.
 - c. Book of Double Bookkeeping, same as no. b. fol. 30pp with wrappers, dated Feb. 1831.
 - d. Book of Architecture, in the same expertly done manner as the three other books. With two beautifully executed folded plates of Greek columns, and with colored ink headings. fol. 8pp and 2 fld. plates; with wrappers, undtd.
